Instructions for use of the Aerochamber with Mask for infants and toddlers

- 1. Remove the cap from the metered dose inhaler (MDI)
- 2. Check the inside of the Aerochamber for any loose foreign objects. Make sure that all parts are in place.
- 3. Place the inhaler mouthpiece into the oval opening in the soft rubber-like end of the Aerochamber.
- 4. Holding the Aerochamber and inhaler firmly, shake vigorously 3 or 4 times.
- 5. Place the mask gently to the face so that the mouth and nose are covered. You must have a good seal so that the medication does not leak out.
- 6. While the child is breathing out, spray one puff from the inhaler into the Aerochamber.
- 7. Hold the mask firmly to the child's face for at least 6 breaths.
- 8. Repeat steps 4 to 7 as directed by your doctor, waiting at least 1 minute between puffs.
- 9. Remove the inhaler and replace the protective cap.

Cleaning Instructions

- 1. Remove the soft rubber-like end of the Aerochamber that holds the metered dose inhaler. DO NOT remove the face mask.
- 2. Soak the Aerochamber and soft rubber-like end in a basin filled with clean, warm water using mild soap to loosen any residue.
- 3. Rinse the Aerochamber and soft rubber-like end in a basin filled with clean, warm water using gentle motion.
- 4. Lightly shake away excess water droplets and place on a clean surface to air dry.
- 5. Be sure the Aerochamber is completely dry before use.
- 6. Replace the soft rubber-like end onto the Aerochamber.
